

COVID-19 Safety Updates

At Muskego Lakes Country Club the safety of our customers, staff and vendors is our number one concern. While we recognize that COVID-19 is an invisible virus and that whenever people are gathered there is an inherent risk of infection, we also want to do everything that we can to create a clean and safe environment at our events. With that in mind, we've made the following changes...

1. Plexiglass sneeze guards have been added at the bar to create a barrier between guests and bar staff.
2. MLCC waitstaff will be wearing masks (when 6 foot distancing can't be maintained).
3. Hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building for use.
4. All staff will be checked for temperature prior to events and must not be higher than 100.4 or they won't be allowed to work.
5. Food Service Specific....
 - Any buffet service will be serviced by Muskego Lakes staff (no guests touching utensils). Only one table allowed at the buffet at a time (no lines).
 - All silverware will be sanitized and prewrapped in napkins and placed on the tables for guest use.
 - Our staff will pour water into guests water glasses prior to dinner service (no pitchers will be left on the tables). Alternatively individually sealed water bottles placed at each place setting are available for purchase by the couple for a \$1 per person fee.
 - Stationary appetizers, desserts and late night food cannot be out for display until they are ready to be served. These items must be passed, served with a staffed buffet style, served to each table or on individual plates for grab and go.
 - Water pitchers, salt and pepper shakers, bread baskets and any other communal table items are not allowed.
 - Self-Serve coffee stations are not allowed. Coffee will be served on demand by Muskego Lakes Staff.
 - Family style meals are not allowed.
6. Muskego Lakes employees will be disinfecting common surfaces and areas routinely throughout event.
7. Additional spacing between chairs will be added at the ceremonies to allow guests to spread out.
8. In order to keep the building clean, all unused/not rented rooms will be locked.
9. We are committed to following the Waukesha County Health Guidelines and are presently operating at a max capacity of 125 guests per hall or 250 guests in the entire upstairs to make social distancing easier.
